IDEA 97 states that, to the maximum extent appropriate, children with disabilities should be educated with children who are not disabled. Special classes, separate school or other removal of children with disabilities from the regular education environment should occur only when the nature or severity of the disability of a child is such that education within regular classes with the use of supplementary aids and services cannot be achieved satisfactorily. In line with this requirement, Ecorse Public Schools embraces the philosophy of full inclusion, believing that special education students can best be educated in the regular classroom. Our teachers accept responsibility for all students in their classroom and modify, accommodate, and adjust teaching techniques and classroom activities to meet the learning abilities of all children.

You will receive an invitation from the intervention specialist or resource teacher to attend an IEP meeting, if necessary, within the first month of your child's enrollment at Ecorse Public Schools.
